SECTION II - PROJECT DESCRIPTION

4) Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

Kester Avenue Elementary School's PTA is seeking this grant in order to fund a mural project for our school. The second mural will be located on an exterior wall adjacent to the cafeteria, office, auditorium and outdoor lunch area; an area of campus that gets a lot of foot traffic and is in serious need of beautification. These new murals will feature imagery and messaging that are intended to promote social-emotional well being and nutrition for our students, staff, and community members. We're working with local artists Skye Amber Sweet and Katie C Shipley to design beautiful artwork that will brighten our campus and our neighborhood.

5) How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large. (Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)

This mural project is intended to beautify our community, our school and perhaps most importantly, to welcome back our students and staff who are returning to school after the extended closures due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The reopening of schools marks the start of a new chapter for our community and the world at large and we believe these murals will help usher in this new chapter with a sense of gratitude, optimism, love, hope, and healing.

Our hope is that investing in the beautification of our community and school will have a positive and artistically therapeutic impact on community members, teachers, administrators, support staff, parents and students. Boosting student morale can have positive effects on behavior and academic performance. As community stakeholders we believe that our public schools are an essential gateway to opportunity for the youngest members of our community, who when nurtured and supported, will grow to become positive, caring, and contributing members of society.



<u>Who are the artists?</u> Artists were selected based on several factors including affordable pricing, quality of work, professionalism, and previous experience completing works of art in public spaces in our neighborhood and beyond.

Artist candidates were invited to attended a campus walkthrough with PTA members and administrators to tour campus and discuss mural ideas. From there, artists submitted quotes detailing the cost, scope, and timeline of proposed work. Stakeholders then compared quotes in order to determine which artists would best meet our needs.

Katie C Shipley was selected to create the front entrance mural.

LETTER OF DETERMINATION

In response to request of this office concerning your PTA's tax-exempt status, a copy of our group ruling letter dated November 18, 1943, from Internal Revenue, which grants federal income tax exemption to all PTAs in California, is enclosed. You will note the Internal Revenue Code section at that time as referred to in the letter was 101(6)—now Section 501(c)(3) as indicated in all PTA bylaws in California. The group exemption number assigned to the California State PTA is GEN-0646.

Also enclosed is a copy of the February 24, 2010 letter from Franchise Tax Board confirming PTA's exemption from state franchise or income tax under Section 23701d of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

Both the federal and state exemption letters cover all of our divisions—local units (associations), councils and districts. The letters are issued to the California Congress of Parents and Teachers, Inc. The corporate name was changed as indicated on this letterhead by vote of the annual convention on May 5, 1978, and has been recorded and filed with the Secretary of State with certificate endorsed on August 14, 1978.

Kester Avenue Elementary PTA is a unit in good standing. It was organized on May 24, 1951 according to our official records, and is chartered as a member organization of the California Congress of Parents, Teachers, and Students, Inc.

Kester Avenue Elementary PTA located at 5353 Kester Avenue, Van Nuys, CA, 91411 in the Thirty-First District, California Congress of Parents, Teachers and Students, Incorporated, is a nonprofit, tax-exempt association under our group ruling. The Employer Identification Number (EIN) assigned to Kester Avenue Elementary PTA is 956204899 and the assigned Franchise Tax Board entity number is 8018449.
