- 1.) Call to order by Jeff Kalban, Chair @ 6:30 p.m.
- 2.) Roll Call: Bob Anderson, Tom Glick, Maria Pavlou Kalban, Sue Steinberg. Present SONC President, Jeffrey Hartsough and SONC Secretary, Gil Imber and Lisa Petrus from PRB. Absent Mikie Maloney and Jackie Diamond.
- 3.) Minutes of February meeting: Motion to approve as written by Bob Anderson, seconded by Tom Glick. Passed unanimously by roll call vote.
- 4.) Elected officials: none
- 5.) Chair's Report: PLUM meeting is March 18. On the agenda, returning with a landscape plan, the small lot subdivision at 14568 Dickens and the proposed Chick Fil A at the old Corkey's site. Vision Committee meets again on April 1. Discussing real world, equitable, affordable housing.
- 6.) New Business: Bob Anderson offered an update report on the Metro Sepulveda Transit Corridor project. Bob is actively monitoring all their proceedings so that Sherman Oaks does not get the raw end of the deal on this project. Maria Kalban spoke briefly about SB 9 and SB 10 and the coalition of neighborhood groups she has organized statewide to fight these bills. The discussion tonight centered on the Specific Plan and how it has been removed from being considered in the Community Plan Update. Tom Glick explained the Options the city was asked to consider when updating the Specific Plan. They chose the least impactful option which disappointed the committee. Tom presented a motion to be sent to the Planning Department to explain our opposition to not opening up the Specific Plan for amendments.  
  
The committee determined that a briefer version of Tom's great analysis would be best. This motion will come back to the committee next month.
