1. Address the recent uptick in area crimes from car beak-ins to home break-ins and how LAPD is adjusting it's assets to meet this change.
2. Pedestrian safety continues to be a focus of the community, especially now that school has begun. Has the promised increased radar enforcement been effective?

Will there be other pedestrian sting operations held near area schools?

3. With the economic downturn, there are more cases of homeless interacting with area home owners and businesses. Are there plans for a "sweep" in our area?
4. How is the LAPD doing in enforcing the closure of illegal Medical Marijuana Clinics in light of pending Court actions?
5. If un-hitched Billboards are illegal, why do we still see so many of them?

6. We helped fund Q Star anti-graffiti cameras as well as cameras along Ventura Blvd. at the request of the LAPD yet many of these units are in-operative due to lack of maintenance. Why?

7. Can Van Nuys Division be more accurate and timely in its broadcasts of alerts on the NIXLE system?

8. Update on search for two Senior Lead Officer positions to be filled by Capt. Snell.
