- a. Megan Whalen of the City Bureau of Engineering gave a thorough presentation of the Los Angeles River Revitalization Plan. Funding for river projects has been obtained by other groups from Proposition K. Quimby funds may also be a possibility. Megan gave several examples of projects that have been done in other areas through joint efforts of several groups. The Bureau of Engineering has applied for a \$1 million planning grant for the river. Sherman Oaks would be included in that planning process if the grant is awarded. A request was made by Karen Sampson for the Bureau to assess connecting the river bike path to the Orange Line bike path through the street network.
