 - d. 4715, 4746 Allot – Area 3
 - e. 4740, 4727, 4721, 4715, 4722 Ventura Canyon – Area 3
 - f. 4261 Hazeltine – Area 6
 - g. 4251 Cobath – Area 7

3. Tree Trimming in Area 5
 - a. Sarah Street – One or two blocks of trees that have not been trimmed. Need to get block numbers.

4. Sidewalks and Alley in Area 4
 - a. 4500 block of Lemona Avenue
 - b. Light pole corner of Lemona and Ventura Boulevard.
 - c. Alley – need to check with Sue Steinberg on location.

5. Sidewalks in Area 4
 - a. 4464 Van Nuys Boulevard – In front of Citybank
 - b. 14445 Moorpark Street – Near stairs to Black Dog Yoga

6. Tree Trimming in Area 2
 - a. 14161 Riverside Drive – On the corner of Calhoun. Two short palm trees.
