II. ADMINISTRATIVE MOTIONS:

Item II. a, A motion to approve Finance Committee draft minutes dated Wednesday, November 30, 2022 as submitted was brought by Howard Katchen and seconded by Cheryl Shapiro. Motion was approved by Finance Committee members, Jeffrey Hartsough, Howard Katchen, Cheryl Shapiro, 3 yes – 0 no, - 2 absent (Levon Baronian & Lisa Petrus)

Katchen and seconded, by Cheryl Shapiro. Motion was unanimously approved by SONC Finance Committee members in attendance, 4 yes, 0 no, Jeffrey Hartsough, Howard Katchen, Cheryl Shapiro, Lisa Petrus, 1 absent – (Levon Baronian). There were no public comments.

Item VI.b, SONC Annual Hello Spring Tree Adoption Event – There was a motion to approve up to \$1,000 for an event to be held on March 25, 2023 (target date) at the Van Nuys Sherman Oaks War Memorial Park. Funds will be utilized for SONC branded promotional materials and event logistical support. A motion to approve was brought by Howard Katchen and seconded, by Lisa Petrus. Motion was unanimously approved by SONC Finance Committee members in attendance, 4 yes, 0 no, Jeffrey Hartsough, Howard Katchen, Cheryl Shapiro, Lisa Petrus, 1 absent – (Levon Baronian). Item VI.c, SONC Election Expenses for 2023 Elections – There was a discussion of the motion brought to approve funding up to \$8,000 for the promotion and execution of the SONC 2023 Elections. Christy Adair thanked the committee for their consideration of additional funding of the LAFD certification program.

Latora Green requested that the Finance committee consider granting more funds to the Valley of Change. She was told to submit a NPG (Neighborhood Purpose Grant) and that we would review past grants given to this non-profit.
