App can be used to summon a car. 60% of their trips are under 5 miles. Advertisement on the car funds the car. \$7,000-\$12,000 per vehicle per month. Trolley system was also considered by this joint session of Vision and Transportation Committees. Trolley carries more people and picks up and drops off at pre-designated areas. Concerns that this trolley may cause traffic jams while dropping off and picking up passengers. Will continue studying transit options.
