The City Of Los Angeles is currently under an emergency order regarding the population of unhoused residents. The current emergency order does not include an eviction moratorium. Rent-debt accumulated during the COVID-19 pandemic is highly likely to be cited in upcoming eviction proceedings. Evictions are more than likely to lead to homelessness.

Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council, Human Services Committee asks that Councilmember Nithya Raman of Council District 4 move to reinstate an eviction moratorium in the City of Los Angeles to take effect immediately and continue until the emergency order - regarding the unhoused resident population - has ended.

In the event a new emergency order is established regarding the unhoused population, we ask the Councilmember move to include an eviction moratorium in the language of the new emergency order.
