2	Riverside Drive north side just east of Van Nuys Blvd. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss options for the park-like area between the river and the 101 Freeway and options for north side of river. 	Stop	10:00-10:15
3	Calhoun/Sunkist north side of the river. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • View river in this area, path along river and options for Sunkist property. 	Stop	10:20-10:40
4	Murietta south side of the river. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • View and discuss the stretch of the river from Hazeltine to Woodman. 	Stop	10:45-11:10
6	Valleyheart Drive between Dixie Canyon and Fulton south side of the river <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • View and discuss Moorpark Triangle. • Discuss options for remainder of river to Fulton Avenue. • Walk to Richard Lilliard Outdoor Amphitheatre 	Final stop	11:15-11:45
