Anthony discussed Emer. Prep. meeting with Colbath Neighborhood Watch group. Jeff will add them to e-mail chain and advise on organizing Watch on Colbath, also with Max on Fulton near Valley Vista.

Advise Committee about the upcoming Board meeting with DOT. Jeff offers to alert and mobilize Greenleaf Watch group to attend meeting. Zach suggested we connect this issue with the Right of Way Encroachment issues along secondary highways like Moorpark, Valley Vista, Riverside which forces pedestrians into the street due to lack of sidewalks and easements being covered with landscaping, fences etc. Will bring up the ""revocable permit"" alternative with Tamar.

Zach advises there seems to be a new medical marijuana facility at 13625 Moorpark. Will place on Agenda for Board meeting. Tamar Galatzan, Neighborhood Prosecutor to be notified that no ""hardship exemption"" has been filed with the City so this may be yet another unlicensed, illegal facility. There are now 30 locations in Van Nuys Division.

Be-briefing on SONC ""Day In The Park"" event on Memorial Day. E-mails collected but still waiting for completion of new SONC web site.
