2. I will brief you on my recent tour of the Office of Emergency Management's new facility in downtown LA.

5. Briefing on Councilperson Janice Hahn's securing 150M\$ in funding to allow all 34,000 of the City's first responders to communicate with each other via radio. This was a recommendation of the 9/11 Commission and we are only now getting around to this in LA!
6. Update of squatters in foreclosed properties. Yes this is back again and a little worse than before in some areas.
