Information was provided to Janet Richmond regarding a neighborhood dispute over noise. She was referred to the City Attorney's Office of Mediation and SLO Lucas Hamilton of LAPD for help with resolution.

Anthony reports on funds raised by Westfield Mall Corp., Notre Dame High School, CD2 and Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council to provide mitigation of speeders in school zones. Brighter, newer school zone signs have been installed near Notre Dame High School. Speed trailers will be positioned to provide a digital read out of speeds as well as store data on traffic speeds along Riverside Drive and Woodman. These trailers will rotate positions. Trees will be trimmed in Spring that obscure School Zone signs along Woodman Ave. South.

Pat Davenport reports on Commission to be named by Councilmember Krekorian to study pedestrian safety and to make recommendations.

Anthony will visit State Assemblyman Mike Furer in Sacramento to discuss ways to make LADOT and State Highway Regulations more responsive to the distinct needs and desires of the community in which these regulations will be implemented. Anthony will discuss with Council Deputy Damian Carroll who was involved in this issue when Councilmember Krekorian was in the State Assembly.
