The Parking Committee convened at 6:30p. In attendance were Craig Buck, Ken Silk and four stakeholders.

A quorum was not in attendance, but the Committee heard from the group of stakeholders who live in an area that is technically not in SONC's area, though it is in Sherman Oaks: that stretch of Sepulveda that runs west of the 405 between Fiume and Mulholland.

The stakeholders were seeking ways of getting the small section of sound wall that ends at Fiume to extend to Mulholland to provide protection for their homes from freeway noise and potential runaway vehicles. The Committee made some suggestions and provided appropriate contacts, but because this is a Caltrans issue, there was nothing we could do in the way of direct action.

There was some discussion of these stakeholders (about 700) applying to the SONC Board for annexation.

Lacking a quorum, no votes were taken. Mr. Buck adjourned the meeting at 7:30.
