Minutes

1. Call to Order by Avo Babian, Chair, at 6:30
2. Roll Call. **Present:** Avo Babian, Sidonia Lax, David Levinson, Deatra Yatman, Gregory Wright (late), Joey Dashut (Alternate) Brian Patton (Alternate)
3. Reviewed and approved minutes of September meeting. Deatra brought the motion to approve. Joey 2nd the motion. Passed Unanimously
4. Public comment on non-agenda items: Deatra asked who we can ask about shade trees in the Park. Avo said he will check with Jeff Hartsough
5. Discussion items:
 - a. LA River-DASH Hub at Mall. No Updates
 - b. BID creation sub-committee: Brian said he is willing to volunteer
 - c. Garden Tour in Sherman Oaks: The flyers have been printed. The homeowner signs are ready. Joey will bring a table for the meeting location. Avo will bring water. Avo brought the SONC branded giveaways. \$100 funds approved by SONC. The tour will begin at 12pm, with a sign up sheet, and tour homes will be handed out. Avo will print them out.
 - d. Clean and Beautify 405 Underpass at Sep and Ventura with Encino NC: Brian said he will do clean up with BID for now, but wants to plan one every quarter next year. David recommended separating beautify from cleanup. Avo agreed on a separate Beautify project
6. Action Items:
 - a. Motion to support the Revitalization of the 405 Underpass at Ventura Blvd, and to support funding for up to \$300. Tabled
7. Updates:
 - a. Sidewalk Trees issues: Regarding the Latest CFAC meeting-David gave a summary. The city is hiring new tree trimming crews. They have allotted \$6.42 Million. Homeowners are responsible for watering Residential Parkway trees. The city wants to get rid of contractors and and wants to do the trimming themselves eventually
 - b. LA River Update: No Update
 - c. Ernie's Walk: No Update
8. New Business- Gregory wanted SONC to oppose the proposition that will allow for Daylight Savings time to be permanent. Also Gregory gave info about ArtRebel Program which does murals in Sherman Oaks.
9. Next Meeting –Next BID Sub Committee meeting on Nov 7rd. Next Green and Beautification Committee meeting will be Dec 5th
