Minutes

1. Meeting called to Order by Avo, Co-chair at 6:40 pm
2. Roll Call: **Present:** Avo Babian, Gil Imber, Bob Rieth
3. Reviewed and approved minutes of Jan Meeting. Gil made the motion to approve, Bob 2nded the motion. Passed Unanimously
4. Public comment on non-agenda items: A question about a fallen lamp post. Told to call 311. Discussion about the 311 app, as well as what services the City provides. Street Sweeping was seen as not useful. But broken lights, Graffiti, Fallen lamp posts are all well taken care of by the city. Also, who is in charge of cleaning Alleys? Research will be done.
5. Discussion items:
 - a. LA DASH-New Route for Van Nuys Studio City DASH: The new route has not been implemented
 - b. Parking improvement Ideas: Tabled
 - c. Ride Share Pick up Drop off Areas: Loading zones were discussed as a practical solution for rideshare pick ups and drop offs. Many details were discussed about white loading and yellow loading zones. Artin asked about trying it out in Sherman Oaks, in the BID area.
 - d. Van Nuys Airport issues: Tom gave an update of the task force and mentioned that the FAA wanted to water down the curfew on nighttime flights. He recommended to come to the Task Force meeting on March 3 at Fly away and send letters to the Mayor.
 - e. Bike Share ideas: Bob mentioned that we should focus on spending funds on improving bike lane and infrastructure for bike riders.
 - f. Solution to Car Traffic in Sherman Oaks
 - i) Hillside Traffic: Gil gave updates on Studies done showing that the flow of traffic is not enough to justify a 2nd lane. Harold asked for an action item, to remove the no right turn on Woodcliff and Raynetta, north bound.
6. Action Items:
 - a. Motion to have a letter of support for funding for a light on Beverly Glen and Valley Vista. Tabled due to lack of info.
7. Updates:
 - a. Sepulveda Corridor Project No Updates.
8. New Business– Jeff Jacobberger, Bike Advocate mentioned new bike paths from the LA River going north on Noble, west on Hatteras and north on Sepulveda to the orange line. Also it's dangerous to cross Sepulveda and Moorpark
9. Next Meeting –. Next Traffic and Transportation meeting, March 11th. Next SONC Board Meeting March 9th
